

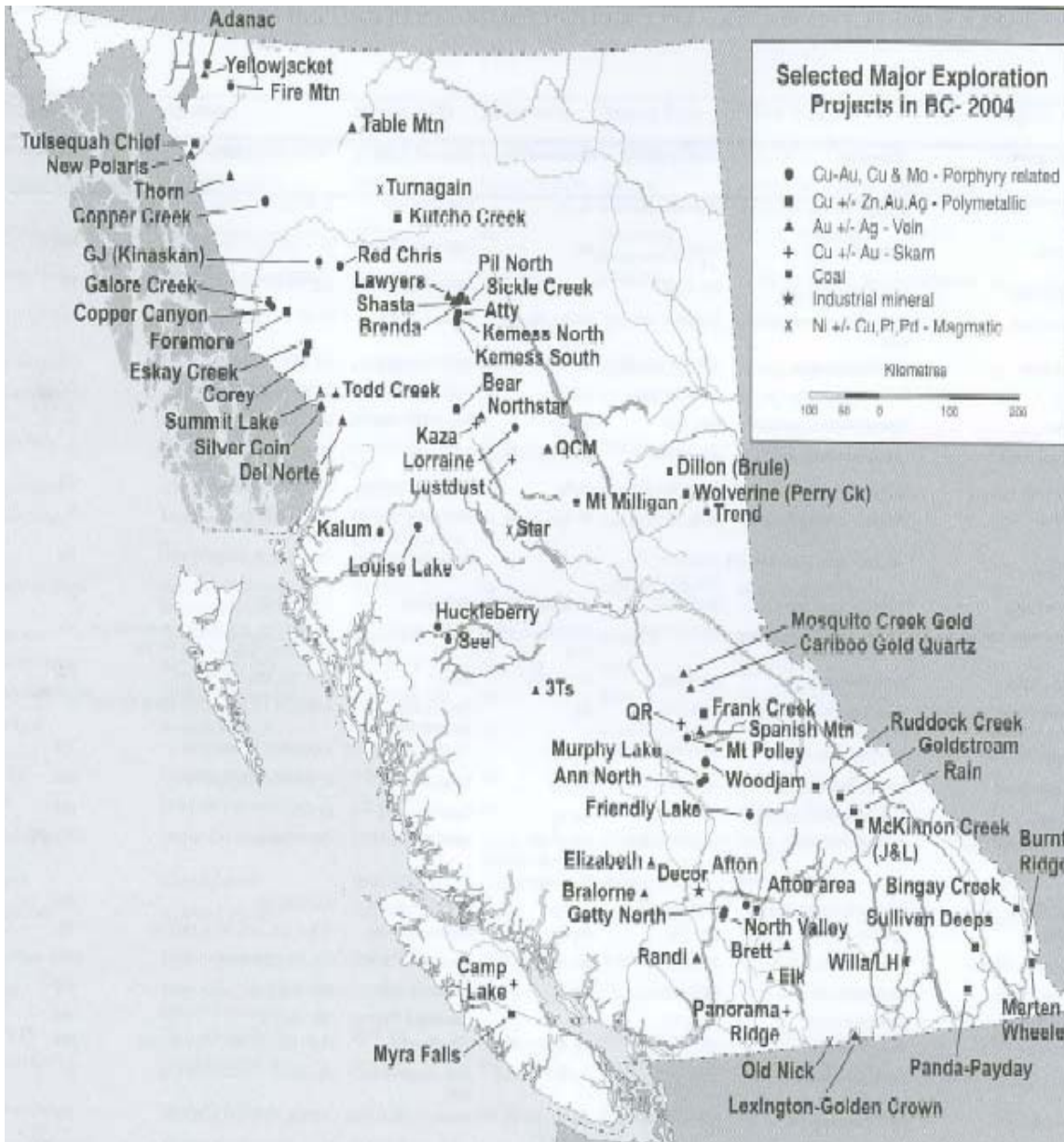

But with the politics right again in BC, analyst Graeme Currie suggests that up to \$155 million could be spent on exploration in British Columbia this summer, so this map should be kept.
